### School History

In September of 1957, Our Lady of Victory Parish School opened its doors to 231 students in grades one through four. Due to a rapid growth of enrollment, a cafeteria and additional classrooms were built in 1960 and 1961. The convent and library were completed in 1963. By then, OLV had developed into an elementary school for students in Kindergarten through 8th grade. In the fall of 1993, an Early Childhood Center opened for Pre-school, Kindergarten and Aftercare. Soon thereafter, a new Art Center was established in 1998. In 2016, the Cathedral Center built a second gym and counseling center. OLV alumni routinely achieve top awards at local high schools while also giving back to their community. In 2008, Texas Department of Education named OLV a National Blue Ribbon School.

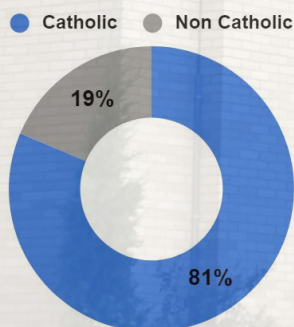

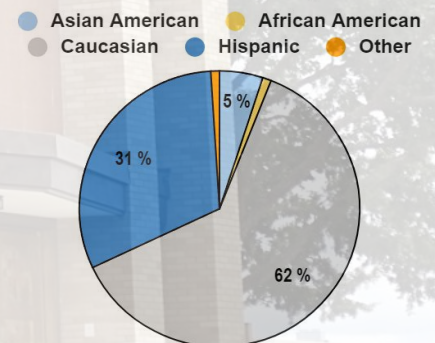
### Catholic & Non Catholic Totals



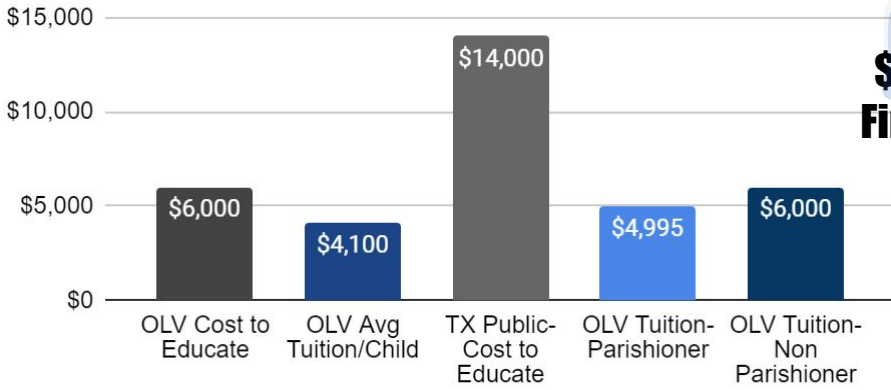

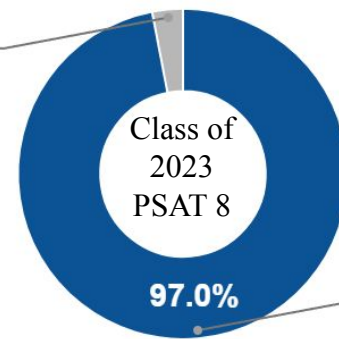
