FINAL REGISTRATION FOR 2018-19

Final registration will be held on Wednesday, May 2nd from 1:30 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. in the cafeteria. It is imperative that every parent, whether their child is a new or returning student, come to the final part of the registration process.

The 2nd part of registration fees and any/all other fees are required to be paid at this time. Forms and payment must be fully completed within 5 working days of that date or a \$25.00 late fee will be assessed, beginning May 10th. Any insufficient checks will be charged a \$20 fee.

If you currently use FACTS to pay tuition your account will automatically be renewed. If you are new to FACTS you need to go online and set up your account ASAP.

Minimum Parish Support

A reminder that ½ of the yearly minimum parish support (\$200.00) is due to the church by June 30, 2018, in order to be classified, for tuition purposes, as a parishioner. Please note that the minimum support is \$400 per year. A late fee of \$50 will be charged if not paid by June 30th and every month after until support is paid. No notices will be mailed.

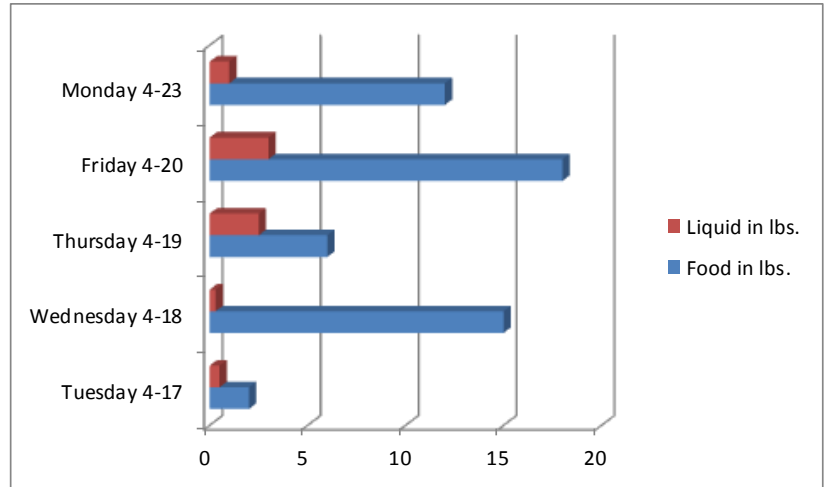

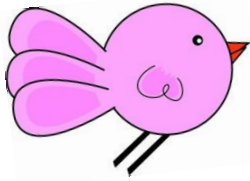
