Reclaim Family Time

From the Desk of the Very Reverend Father Gary W. Janak

A most blessed New Year to all of you! We started the New Year with the celebration of the Solemnity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of God. We also celebrate World Day of Prayer for Peace, which surfaces a few questions for me: How much peace is in our home? In our marriage? In our family?



On the topic of peace and family life, Saint Teresa of Calcutta writes, "I think the world today is upside down. Everybody seems to be in such a terrible rush, anxious for greater development and greater riches and so on. There is much suffering because there is so very little love in homes and in family life. We have no time for our children, we have no time for each other; there is no time to enjoy each other. In the home begins the disruption of the peace of the world...If you want to bring peace to the whole world, go home and love your family."

Strong, but all too often true words. If, as Saint Teresa writes, it is in the home where the disruption of the peace of the world begins, it is also in the home where the beginning of peace can be found. As the familiar song states, "Let there be peace on earth and let it begin with me..."

instead of making New Year's resolutions that will be forgotten or unfulfilled by next month, what if we simply said, "This year, I am going to do my best, regardless of the circumstances, to be more at peace with

myself and others." God wants us to be a peace. Scripture reminds us: "Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God which surpasses all understanding will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus" (Phil. 4:6-7).

I offer you a few simple, but profound suggestions, from Lisa Jacobson at forthefamily.org, as we seek to begin this New Year of 2020, as men and women of peace

TEN LITTLE THINGS THAT CAN HELP BRING PEACE INTO OUR HOME:

 SPEAK KINDLY. It's amazing how a little kindness goes a long way in setting the proper tone for the home.

 GATHER REGULARLY. For meals. For prayer. To simply hang out with each other. Enjoy our togetherness.

 LAUGH READILY. Joke and play. Be ready to have a good time with each another. Lighten one another's load with a good laugh.

 WORK CHEERFULLY. It seems there's always a job to be done. So why not make the most of it? Do all things without complaining and disputing. (Phil. 2:14).

 GIVE GENEROUSLY. Of our time, our possessions. Our home is a place full of all kinds of giving opportunities. FORGIVE QUICKLY. Don't waste time nursing a grudge. Let it go right away and get on with a loving relationship.

7. HUG FREELY. Give our little ones a squeeze. Wrap our arms around our big kids, as well. My spouse could probably use one too!

8. PRAY FREQUENTLY. We will ask God to bring peace into our home. Lift up the needs of the day. Seek Him for wisdom when we're stumped (or even when we're not).

 CHEER LOUDLY. Let our family know we are behind them. All the way. Offer our enthusiastic support. Who doesn't need to hear a warm cheer now and then?

10. LOVE GENUINELY. Seems obvious, I know. But sometimes we forget how powerful love can be in our home. And above all things have fervent love for one another, for "love will cover a multitude of sins." (I Pet. 4:8)

Let us pray to be instruments of God's peace to our spouse, family and to all the world. After all, it begins with us. I believe Saint Teresa got it right, "If you want to bring peace to the whole world, go home and love your family."
