I would like to wish all families a happy and safe new year. In looking back on 2020, I would like to thank you for your flexibility and generosity throughout the year. As a school, we were able to successfully adjust and adapt through the various changes of 2020. One of those adjustments was freezing tuition and fees for 2020-21 to assist our families. As we move into 2021, keeping tuition rates affordable for both small and large families was a goal. Our average student tuition cost continues to be much lower than nearby private schools and below what it cost to educate your child. Through donations, fundraisers, and parish support, we are able to subsidize this difference in cost and provide a high quality education. Although we will raise tuition moderately, our goal is also to reduce small fees for next year to help be more efficient with our time.

Providing a high quality, faith-filled education for a diverse set of families remains consistent with our mission. Finances should not deter families from a quality education. This past year we provided nearly \$200,000 through various forms of assistance. 



